JUMMP YOUTH MINISTRY CODE OF CONDUCT

To help insure that participants have a good, safe time, the following Code of Conduct will be in effect during *all* JUMMP youth events.

Parents and youth participants are to review this document and keep for their records.

1. Participants are expected to participate in assigned activities.
2. Dress is casual. Jeans, T-shirts, etc., are fine. Clothing with offensive or obscene words, pictures, symbols, etc. is not acceptable. Shirts must be worn at all times. No halter tops, tank tops or sleeveless shirts are allowed. Shorts/skirt length must be appropriate (when a person is standing straight with arms hanging to side, shorts must meet or pass their fingertips). Pants must not sag, or a belt will be provided.
3. Language and conduct should reflect the values we proclaim as Catholics. Participants must show respect to all adult leaders and peers *at all times*. Disrespect of each other and adult leaders will not be tolerated.
4. Participants are to remain with their group at all times during youth events unless otherwise directed by adult leaders.
5. Only the Director of Youth Ministry can alter plans/timing of any scheduled activity.
7. Smoking and the use of tobacco products is not allowed by any participants during any youth event. Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the event.
8. The possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons will not be tolerated. Breaking this rule will mean immediate dismissal from the event. (Parents will be called, regardless of the hour.)
9. The use of cell phones/pagers is prohibited *during* catechesis classes, retreats, special presentations, etc.
10. Participants should not bring food and/or drinks unless otherwise directed by the adult leader(s).
